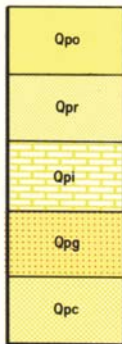
QUATERNARY

RECENT



- Orn** Eolian sand—calcareous and siliceous sand; forming coastal dunes
- Oro** Colluvium—calcareous clay; containing limestone fragments in some areas
- Org** Lagoonal mud—calcareous gypsiferous mud

PLEISTOCENE



- Qpo** Eolian sand—siliceous sand containing sheet and nodular kankar at or near the surface; forming coastal dunes
- Qpr** Residual clay and kankar—calcareous clay containing sheet and nodular kankar; overlies Nullarbor Limestone
- Qpi** Residual clay and kankar—sandy clay containing sheet and nodular kankar—overlies or replaces eolian limestone
- Qpg** Lagoonal mud—calcareous gypsiferous mud
- Qpc** **ROE CALCARENITE:** shelly marine calcarenite

TERTIARY

LOWER
MIOCENE



- Tmn** **NULLARBOR LIMESTONE:** foraminiferal calcarenite
- Tmnm** **Mullamullang Limestone Member:** algal limestone—nodules of calcareous red algae in a matrix of foraminiferal calcarenite
- Tma** **ABRAKURRIE LIMESTONE:** Porous bryozoan calcirudite and calcarenite
